



Church Loan Impact




Supporting NC Baptists

Provision remains steadfast in its mission in supporting North Carolina Baptists through several services including ministry grants, scholarships, trust administration, and church loans. Throughout 2023, we made huge strides in the number of churches and individuals impacted by these services.

In 2023, we distributed a total of \$7,423, 699 to NC Baptists. Behind this number are students being able to earn a college education, churches now able to fund outreach programs, and churches gathering in newly built sanctuaries.
